20 the period between November 10, 2025 and December 2, 2025 , with intent to deprive another of  
21 property, to-wit: merchandise, did on November 10th, 2025 and December 2, 2025 wrongfully  
22 obtain or exert unauthorized control over such property belonging to a mercantile establishment,  
23 to-wit: Ulta Beauty Inc., and with intent to deprive another of property, to-wit: merchandise, did  
24 on November 10th, 2025 and December 2, 2025 wrongfully obtain or exert unauthorized control  
over such property belonging to a mercantile establishment, to-wit: Ulta Beauty Inc., and the  
total aggregate value of all of such property was \$5,000 or more;

Contrary to RCW 9A.56.350(1)(c), (2), (4), and against the peace and dignity of the State  
of Washington.

**Count 2: Organized Retail Theft In The First Degree**

the period between December 5, 2025 and December 10, 2025 , with intent to deprive another of  
property, to-wit: merchandise, did on December 5, 2025 and December 10, 2025 wrongfully

4 over such property belonging to a mercantile establishment, to-wit: Ulta Beauty Inc., and the  
5 total aggregate value of all of such property was \$5,000 or more;



8 Certification, Discovery, and Defendant's criminal history; I further declare that: On January 10,  
9 2026, the Court found probable cause for the same incidents based on a Superform submitted by  
10 Seattle Police Officer Lauren Laumbattus under incident number 26-8062. The information  
11 contained in that Superform is identical to the information provided in Josh Velliquette's  
12 Certification for Determination of Probable Cause.

19 At First Appearance, the Court set bail in the amount of **\$50,000.00**; pursuant to CrR  
20 2.2(b)(2)(i), the State respectfully requests that bail remain in that amount because the defendant  
21 is unlikely to appear in response to a summons or voluntarily avail himself of the judicial  
22 process.

23 **Currently Charged Offense:** As the Certification for Determination of Probable Cause  
24 describes, the defendant entered several Ulta Beauty Stores from North Seattle to Federal Way in  
King County and took merchandise, passing all points of sale without paying for them.

2           On 11/10/25, the defendant entered Ulta Beauty at 13201 Aurora Ave N, took  
3 merchandise and exited the store without making any attempt to pay for the items. The total loss  
4 was \$661.00.

5           On 11/18/25, the defendant with two other suspects entered Ulta Beauty at 13201 Aurora  
6 Ave N, took merchandise and exited the store without making any attempt to pay for the items.  
7 The total loss was \$620.00.

8           On 11/22/25, the defendant entered Ulta Beauty at 13201 Aurora Ave N, took  
9 merchandise and exited the store without making any attempt to pay for the items. The total loss  
10 was \$383.00.

11           On 11/23/25, the defendant entered Ulta Beauty at 13201 Aurora Ave N, took



2           **Warrant History:** According to JABS, Washington courts have issued 56 misdemeanor  
3 warrants and 19 superior court warrants since 1989, including 2 currently active from Edmonds  
4 Municipal Court; those warrants remain active at the time of this writing.

5           **Requested Conditions of Release:** The State requests standard conditions of release,  
6 including appearing for all required court hearings, providing updated contact information to the  
7 court, and committing no new law violations, and further that the defendant have no contact with  
8 any Ulta in Washington State.

9           Given the prolific pattern of serial thefts spanning 55 days and involving 24 reported and  
10 confirmed incidents, as well as the fact that the individual has two active warrants, one pending  
11 in Edmonds Municipal Court under Theft Cause No. 5A0691848 since October 7, 2025, the  
12 State does not believe he will voluntarily submit himself to the criminal justice system.

13           Accordingly, the State respectfully requests that this Court maintain the \$50,000 bond set  
14 at the initial appearance, along with the State's other requested conditions of release.

That Josh Velliquette is a Detective with the Seattle Police Department and has reviewed the investigation conducted in Seattle Police Department Case Number 2025-330106;

There is probable cause to believe that David J. Gama (White/Male DOB: 10/10/65) committed the crime(s) of RCW 9A.56.350 - Organized Retail Theft in the First Degree within the City of Seattle, County of King, State of Washington.

This belief is predicated on the following facts and circumstances:

**Background:**

This Organized Retail Theft investigation spans 55 days and includes 24 incidents. The first incident occurred on 11/10/25 and the last incident occurred on 1/4/26. During this specific investigation, David was responsible for \$18,426.80 in loss. Only \$1,678.80 in merchandise was recovered when David was arrested under SPD 25-365714.



David's physicals list him as being a sixty-year-old white male, 5'7" tall, 170 pounds, with black hair and brown eyes.

I conducted a criminal history inquiry on David and noted he has a criminal history in Washington. David has been arrested fifty times since 1985. He has five felony, nineteen gross misdemeanor, and eleven misdemeanor convictions. His relevant convictions include Theft-2 and Theft-3.

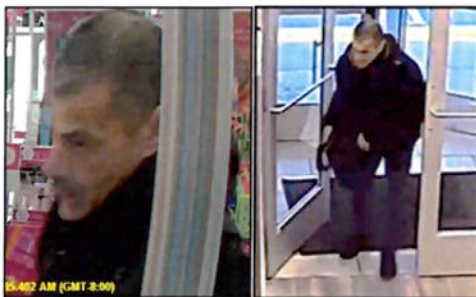

Due to the thoroughness of the report, I am including it in whole, with only changes made to formatting:

“On 12/14/2025, at approximately 11:50 hours, I was working as a fully uniformed police officer, in a fully marked Seattle Police patrol unit, as 2-Nora-21. I was dispatched to Felony Shoplift INV at 13201 Aurora AV N, Ulta Beauty. The call log stated, “SHOPLIFT I/P, TOOK \$2,000 IN FRAGRANCE, FLED ON FOOT NB AURORA AV, NO WPNS.”

I was on a premise check in the 13200 block of Aurora AV N for crime prevention in an area known for significant shoplifting issues at a variety of retailers in the shopping center. I heard Dispatch broadcast a call for a shoplifter, who had just left Ulta Beauty. I immediately logged to the call and located the Suspect, identified as David Gama DOB 10/10/1965 approximately a half a block away. S/Gama, who

did not have ID on him, was identified via a booking photo from King County Jail. Additionally, S/Gama was identified from a DOL photo attached to the call by RTCC.

Initially, based on the description of the Suspect by Ulta Beauty, along with at least one other person in the area, possibly matching the description, I requested a better description of the Suspect. Upon obtaining the better description, I determined the Suspect I initially saw, walking east on the street/alley between Wells Fargo Bank and Aurora Donuts and Ice Cream was our likely Suspect. S/Gama did not have the orange Ulta bag described in the call, but he was carrying a brown paper grocery bag. As I was trying to determine if S/Gama was the Suspect, I watched him put the brown paper grocery bag on a bus stop bench, at the southbound bus stop, on Aurora AV N, just south of N 135 St, and S/Gama was standing in the immediate area of the grocery bag. S/Gama was detained at that time.

Officer Weiss #8793 was able to bring the witness, Damon Nelson, to our location for a field show up. Witness Nelson stated it was the Suspect he witnessed walking out of Ulta Beauty with stolen items. Upon confirming Subject Gama was the Suspect, S/Gama was advised he was under arrest for felony level shoplift under RCW 9A.56.040 Theft 2 Shoplifting. Once S/Gama was arrested, the brown shopping bag was searched incident to arrest. Multiple bottles of perfume, from Ulta, were located inside the bag. Officer Fason #8421 took photographs of the stolen merchandise and uploaded it into AXON evidence.com. A photograph was also taken of an itemized non-sale receipt and added as an attachment. The DOL photo of S/Gama, as provided by RTCC has been added as an attachment. S/Gama was Mirandized at that time. The arrest was screened by SGT Lima #7760. S/Gama was booked into King County Jail. W/Nelson provided a recorded interview statement regarding this incident. W/Nelson was provided an AXON community request for video of this incident as well. An SPD business card with my name, serial number, and the incident number was provided to Ulta Beauty management regarding this incident.

During the course of the investigation, I learned that S/Gama has repeatedly shoplifted from this specific Ulta Beauty. Ulta Beauty management believes it is approximately 25,000 to 30,00 dollars' worth of fragrance. This has been occurring since W/Nelson, who is an on-site manager, believes it has been going on since at least October of 2025. W/Nelson has provided two separate cast numbers regarding S/Gama. They are 25-35946 and 25-353238. Based on the information provided by W/Nelson and Ulta Operations Manager Louise Frias, as well as spontaneous statements made by S/Gama to Officer Xu #8705, I developed Probable Cause for Organized Retail Theft under RCW 9A.56.350."

It was later determined after itemization of the stolen merchandise by Ulta Beauty staff that David attempted to steal fifteen bottles of fragrance, worth an attempted loss of \$1,678.80 for Ulta Beauty. The incident was captured in-store via video surveillance cameras.

**Analysis:**

David was originally identified by Chelsea S. Tower (White/Female DOB: 10/30/87), a regional Organized Retail Crime Investigator for Ulta Beauty (reference included identification statement). After reviewing the media for all the cases for this investigation, I referenced the most recent booking photo for David and determined his identity to be correct based on general appearance and facial features.

Furthermore, I reviewed SPD Incident 25-365714, which was one of Gama's most recent shoplifts from Ulta Beauty on Aurora. This shoplift resulted in David's arrest, the recovery of fifteen bottles of fragrance worth an attempted loss of \$1,678.80 for Ulta Beauty and provided an up close and clear view of his face and his clothing.

David's general appearance and physical characteristics remained consistent throughout these twenty-four incidents. For twenty of the twenty-four incidents, David's face is unconcealed and can be seen clearly. The rest of David's head and his consistent dress style can be seen during the other two incidents where an attempt at concealment is made. David's 5'7" height, 170-pound weight, black hair, brown eyes, and clean-shaven face all remained the same during the entire investigation. Furthermore, David can be seen wearing similar or identical items of clothing during numerous incidents. For example, David can be seen wearing a tan or clay colored hoodie on 11/18, 11/22, 11/23, and 11/26. David can be seen wearing the same distinctive white and black flannel top on 11/22, 11/26, and 11/29, and David can be seen wearing the same black jacket with red accents on 1/1, 1/3, and 1/4. In general, David can be seen wearing very similar clothing throughout the investigation such as jackets, hoodies, dark pants, and dark shoes.

The modus operandi of David is largely consistent as well. David typically enters the store with his own bag or grabs an orange Ulta Beauty reusable shopping bag and walks directly to the fragrance department. In the fragrance department, he grabs numerous bottles of fragrance, places them in a bag or on his person, and exits the store after passing all points of purchase without paying for the selected merchandise. David has been seen waiting at bus stops (reference his arrest on 12/14) and selling the stolen bottles of fragrance to buyers down around 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave and Pine St by local loss prevention employees such as Chelsea Tower (reference her included statement).

As referenced earlier, David has an established history of stealing. He has convictions for Theft-2 and Theft-3. David has accumulated at least twenty-four known shoplifts in the past two months and has accounted for over \$18,000.00 in loss for Ulta Beauty alone. Due to these reasons, I believe David will continue to routinely steal from businesses around the city until he is held accountable for his actions.
