18 1/21/2018) , a human being; attempt as used in the above charge means that the defendant
19 committed an act which was a substantial step towards the commission of the above described
20 crime with the intent to commit that crime;

21 Contrary to RCW 9A.28.020 and 9A.40.030(1), and against the peace and dignity of the
22 State of Washington.

6 prepared by Detective Lydia Penate of the Seattle Police Department for case number **2026-113613**.

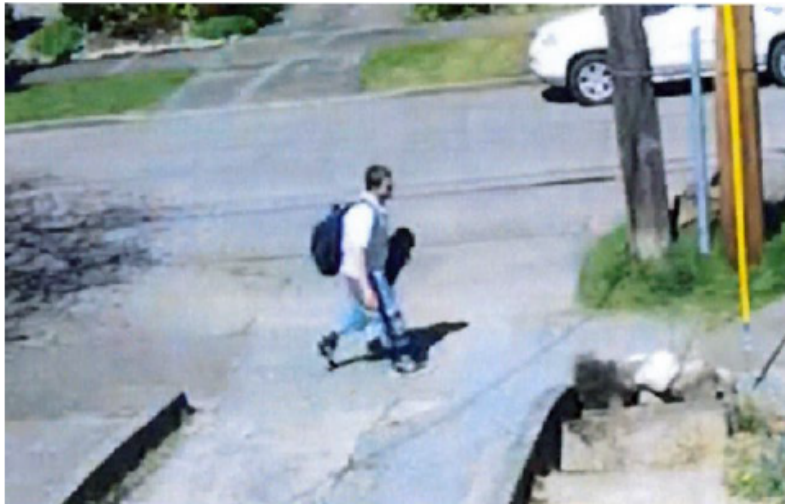
7 I, Rhyan C. Anderson, Senior Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, declare that I have reviewed the
8 Certification, Discovery, and Defendant's criminal history; I further declare that:

9 Surveillance captured video of the defendant from the time of the crime (4/25/26). The next day,
10 when Detective Penate interviewed the defendant, she showed him the still shot of the surveillance
11 and the defendant confirmed it was him in the surveillance. Below is a screenshot of Detective
12 Penate's report:

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21 Bugge-Marcum confirmed that the person in still shot shown above, is him.

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3 Under penalty of perjury of the laws of the State of Washington, I, Rhyan C. Anderson, Senior

9 **Pursuant to CrR 2.2, the State requests bail set in the amount of \$750,000.00, the**
10 **same amount set at the defendant's first appearance.** No less restrictive alternative to
11 incarceration nor lesser bail amount can mitigate the risks that the defendant poses to members
12 of the community, particularly minors.

13 This defendant approached a young 8-year-old little girl sitting alone on a tree stump.
14 The defendant observed that this child was alone and accessible, as her friends had momentarily
15 stepped inside the house. The defendant attempted to grab and drag this child away from the
16 house while the child screamed in terror. This 8-year-old described that she was scared and
17 thought she was going to be killed. Thankfully, the victim's friend alerted an adult and the
18 defendant fled. Witnesses comforted the crying, terrified child until police arrived.

19 While the defendant has no known WA criminal history, the State is concerned about the
20 likelihood of the defendant committing additional violent offenses against children. The brazen
21 nature of the defendant's predatory crime – committed against a young child in broad daylight on
22 a residential street full of children – demonstrates the extreme risk he poses to the community.
23 Further, the defendant told the police that he lived only a short distance away from where the

2 crime occurred. Should the defendant be released, he would immediately return to the area of
3 where the victim and involved children live. Bail in the amount of \$750,000 is necessary to
4 protect other young children from the defendant's crimes.

5 If the defendant is able to post bail, the State requests the Court order him onto Electronic
6 Home Detention. The State requests an Anti-Harassment order protecting the named victim, an
7 order to surrender weapons, and an order prohibiting him from having any contact with any
8 minors. Other conditions include: appear at all future hearings, keep address updated with the
9 court, and commit no further law violations.

That Lydia Penate is a Detective with the Seattle Police Department and has reviewed the investigation conducted in Seattle Police Department Case number 2026-113613 ; There is probable cause to believe that Cristien Xavier Bugge-Marcum (DOB 12/6/03) committed the crime(s) of Attempted Kidnapping in the Second Degree in violation of RCW 9A.40.030 within the City of Seattle, County of King, State of Washington.

This belief is predicated on the following facts and circumstances:

The juvenile victim is identified as SH (DOB 1/21/18). The juvenile witness is identified as FH (DOB 10/18/16). The following information is from the victim, witnesses, and from Cristien X. Bugge-Marcum (DOB 12/6/03).

On 4/25/2026 at approximately 1359 hours, officers were dispatched to 3627 SW Othello St to investigate a report of an attempted kidnapping. The call notes read as follows:

“GROUP OF NEIGHBORHOOD CHILDREN PLAYING IN RP'S YARD, AND 8 YO FEMALE JUST TOLD RP A MALE SUSP TRIED TO GRAB HER ARM AND TAKE HER. SUSP LOCATION UNKNOWN.”

ST (DOB 9/9/80) is the owner of the 3627 SW Othello St residential home. He called 9-1-1.

AM (DOB 5/15/85) lives at 3633 SW Othello st. Her daughter is FH. FH was at the neighbor’s house playing with other neighborhood kids. At 1343 hours, AM told FH to return home for lunch. She got this precise time by checking her doorbell camera which captured when she exited her front door. After going back into her home, she heard her dogs barking at someone walking eastbound past her house and on the south sidewalk. She looked outside and observed a white male carrying a skateboard walking past her house.

JO (DOB 6/25/76) lives at 3613 SW Othello Way which is three houses east of the scene. JO showed officers his surveillance footage. In the video, dogs are heard barking at 1:47:02PM, a shrill scream is heard at 1:47:08 PM, a noise similar to skateboard wheels on a hard surface is heard at 1:47:29PM, an object crashing on the ground is heard at 1:47:34PM, a voice is heard yelling something unintelligible at 1:47:39PM, a male enters the frame on the camera at 1:47:42PM and is walking eastbound on the south sidewalk. The unknown male continued walking eastbound down the sidewalk and out of frame. In the footage, the only person observed was a white male with short hair wearing a white t-shirt, dark colored backpack, a skateboard in his left hand, black and white shoes, jean shorts that either sagged down near his ankles or were just long jean shorts.

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OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

SH is eight years old and lives at 7312 36th Ave SW. On 4/25/26 she was playing with friends outside of 3627 SW Othello st. At one point, she was outside alone and seated on a tree stump. The tree stump is about 35-40 feet away from the sidewalk and near the front of the house. She was looking into the open door of the home while waiting for her friend FH to finish playing a game inside and join her outside.

During SH's Child Forensic Interview (CFI) on 4/28/26, she stated the following:

While she was outside, a "guy" walked by with a skateboard and a backpack. She believed he was wearing a black sweatshirt, but she thought nothing of it. She stated that 5 minutes later, that same person grabbed her arm and tried to drag her away. SH stated that she screamed. When FH came to door after she heard her scream, the suspect ran behind the house and ran away.

SH stated that she could not see the suspect's hair and could not see if it was a male or a female but saw their blue/green eyes.

SH said that she could feel the suspect squeezing her arm and felt pressure. She saw the suspect's skateboard and backpack on the ground when he was trying to drag her away. The suspect did not saying anything to her.

SH stated she was so scared her teeth were chattering and thought that she could have been killed.

FH is 9-years old. FH was inside the home when she heard SH scream. She looked outside and observed the unknown male pulling SH away. She described the male pulling SH with one hand while holding a knife in his other hand. FH went inside and told another child what was happening who then relayed to an adult what was happening. When FH went back outside the unknown male was no longer in front of the home. She observed SH crying near the house.

FH demonstrated the male pulling SH about 5-6 feet and away from the home.

On 4/26/2026 at approximately 1249 hours Bugge-Marcum was observed in the area of 36 Ave SW/SW Orchard St by officers. He matched the description of the surveillance footage seen by officers. Bugge-Marcum was contacted and taken into custody. He was transported to SPD Headquarters.

Bugge-Marcum was read his Miranda Rights and stated in a recorded interview that he has been living at the accessory dwelling unit at 3665 SW Othello St, Seattle WA 98126 for approximately one week with his friends Sam and Sarah who he is in a "situationship" with. He is originally from Sequim/Port Angeles area.

Bugge-Marcum stated that on 4/25/26 he slept in and stayed at Sam and Sarah's residence until approximately 1300 hours. He left to assist his mother with groceries and arrived at his parent's house at approximately 1400 hours. He went shopping in Northgate at approximately 1600 hours. He returned to his parents' house at approximately 1700 hours. He took a nap and left his parents' house at approximately 2000 hours. He stated that he did not return to West Seattle until 0100 hours on 4/26/26.



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**CERTIFICATION FOR DETERMINATION
OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

Bugge-Marcum stated that on 4/25/26 he was wearing jorts, a green zip up or a white Adidas zip up, a white t-shirt, and black and white sneakers, he was carrying a blue backpack and his skateboard. He had his cell phone on him and stated it was an android.


Bugge-Marcum stated that the people in the neighborhood are uptight. He said he got in trouble for smoking in the neighborhood and as a result, he walks eastbound on Othello St from Sarah and Sam's residence and then northbound on 36th Ave SW to the water towers to smoke. He thinks the neighbors might have pinned whatever happened on him.

Bugge-Marcum provided an outline of his route on 4/25/26. He walked eastbound from Sam and Sarah's to 36th Ave SW, then southbound to SW Webster St, then northbound on 35th Ave SW to the bus stop on the east side of 35th Ave SW. He stated that he did not see a single person when he was walking on SW Othello St. He said he went straight to the bus stop.

Bugge-Marcum denied touching anyone and said nothing out of the ordinary happened.
