Our coaching staff will help our 8U-12U players learn to play the game right by teaching them the fundamentals of the game in a positive and fun environment. For our 13U-15U players it is our priority to help prepare them to play high school ball and for our 16U-18U players to help them continue their development and help them to play at a higher level if they are committed and dedicated to do so.

Our elite coaching staff comprises of current and past college players, current and past minor leaguers, current and past pro players, high school coaches, as well as current and past college and professional coaches. We have a wealth of combined coaching/player experience with a love of the game and a love for teaching the game. We are committed to putting the players development first.

### **Here is what the players and families will receive:**

#### **Great Facilities and Equipment**

Washington Baseball Academy teams will train out of Go Time Athletics indoor training facilities in Georgetown and West Seattle. Go Time Athletics facilities are designed to allow players to improve their game while working out in a professional atmosphere. Weight room areas are available for our high school players.

#### **Training and Practice**

Off season indoor training October - February will consist of position specific training that will include pitching, fielding, catching, and hitting from our experienced coaches. There will be weekly team practices and speed/agility/conditioning sessions available. In Feb/March outdoor practices will start.

#### **Price**

A priority of our program is to provide our high-level training program while keeping the cost as affordable as possible. Training out of Go Time Athletics and by being a part of the Pacific Northwest League with Perfect Game Northwest significantly helps keep the cost to train and play lower.

**15U - 18U: \$3,175 per player**

**13U - 14U: \$2,975 per player**

**11U-12U: \$2,275 per player**

**8U - 10U: \$1,775 per player**

(covers team off-season training, practices, fields, uniforms, league play, and local tournaments).

### **Less Travel**

With the locations of our Georgetown and West Seattle locations we have made it easier for our Seattle families to have easy access to a quality select program offering high level training and development close to home. Our indoor training facilities as well as our practice and game fields will be conveniently located to serve the West Seattle, White Center, Burien, Sea-Tac, Highline, Normandy Park, Tukwila, Renton, Capitol Hill, Rainier Valley and Beacon Hill areas.

### **Games and Tournaments**

Our 10U-18U teams will be participating in the Pacific Northwest League with Perfect Game NW. Games will range from 10-14 game season with playoffs depending on age and divisions.

Washington Baseball Academy teams will play in Perfect Game, GLC, WCP and other local tournaments throughout the spring and summer. Out of state tournaments will also be scheduled based on player availability and parent involvement. Out of state tournaments will be an additional cost.

### **Coaches Support**

Support for our younger, parent coached teams is also an important part of our program. Washington Baseball Academy parent coaches will be supported by our high school, college and professional level coaching staff. It is important to provide training to our coaches to provide them with additional knowledge to help them be more successful on both the practice and playing field. We will provide coaching seminars and clinics for our coaching staff.

### **Parent Support**

Support for our parents is also an important part of our program. Washington Baseball Academy and Go Time Athletics is owned and run by a parent of a college baseball player with experience in Pony, Little League, select ball, showcases, high school, college recruiting, collegiate, prospect level events and MLB prospect experience. With baseball parents, high school coaches and college coaches on staff we will be available to answer questions and guidance for families as they weave their way through the baseball experience
